Appointment of Guardian in the Event of Future Need

Designating a Guardian may be needed in the event a Medical Power of Attorney or a Statutory Durable Power of Attorney have not been executed or are not recognized by third-parties.

In addition to naming a person to serve as Guardian, the ability to disqualify one or more individuals from serving as Guardian can be critical in preventing such individuals from being named as Guardian.

Appointment of Agent to Control Disposition of Remains

Execution of this document can help prevent conflict between family members regarding the disposition of a person's remains following their passing.

Identification of the person to serve as Agent, and instructions as to the manner by which one's remains are to be handled, are set forth in this document.
